
# "Pumpkin Patch" Tour



**DAY ONE** - Enroute travel day through Ohio and Pennsylvania. Overnight in the Pocono Mountains at a historic inn in eastern Pennsylvania. Dinner (included) tonight at the resort.

**DAY TWO** – Breakfast (included). Travel to the Atlantic seaboard this morning and visit **Mystic, CT**. This picturesque village at the mouth of the Mystic River offers many unique shops and restaurants for you to enjoy. Late afternoon check-in at your home for the next two nights in Seekonk, MA (Providence Rhode Island Area). **DAY THREE** – Breakfast included. This morning, start with a guided driving tour of the **Newport Mansions** on the famous **Ten Mile Ocean Drive** along the sea in Rhode Island. You'll see where the "American Aristocracy" built their splendid summer palaces. Then go inside the Breakers Mansion for a guided tour of this 70-room estate built by Cornelius Vanderbilt II. Free time this early afternoon to browse and have lunch (not included) along Newport's colorful waterfront and all is has to offer. After a full day enjoying Newport, return to your hotel for a chance to freshen up before dinner (included) tonight at a special location in Providence, RI.

Maine is known for its blueberries and a trip here would not be complete without a visit to **Stonewall Kitchen**. Here you'll find a wide variety of blueberry products, specialty foods, gifts, kitchen utensils, tableware, recipes, and more. This evening a special Maine tradition awaits us for dinner. A **classic down-east lobster bake dinner** with sing-a-long entertainment is on the menu. Return to Portsmouth this evening.

**DAY SIX** – Breakfast included. Depart Portsmouth this morning and drive north in New Hampshire towards the beautiful White Mountains. In Wolfeboro, N.H., board the **MS Mt. Washington Cruise Boat** for an unforgettable cruise on **Lake Winnepesaukee**. Winnepesaukee, the largest lake in New Hampshire, is located in the foothills of the **White Mountains**. As you enjoy this narrated, fall foliage scenic board ride, you'll cruise by magnificent homes, cottages and small islands, with the breathtaking White Mountains as a backdrop. Arrive at Weirs Beach, NH, for lunch and time to browse this quaint lake side village before departing for nearby Vermont. Arrive this late afternoon in Fairlee, VT at a lovely lakefront resort. 
